- 1. It is located in the town of Pavia, just 35 km from Milan, the financial and business capital of Italy, with trains to Milan every 10 minutes and with a population of population of 70,000 inhabitants.
- 2. It boasts of a university body consisting of **26,400 students**, **2,800 international students and 1,800** professors, lecturers, native language teachers and administrative staff.
- **3.** It offers great internship and training opportunities in institutions and companies such as San Matteo Hospital (**ranked 7**th **in Italy and 250**th **worldwide**)
- 4. It offers affordable education with tuition fees based on GDP per capita per year.
- **5.** Single-cycle, bachelor's and master's degree courses based on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics), medicine and psychology taught in English.
- **6. Full scholarship and housing aid programme** under the EDISU right to education programme, including one meal per day.
- 7. It was ranked 423rd in the QS World University Rankings. According to the **Censis Italian Universities 2024/25 Ranking**, it was named 2nd Best large public University (20.000-40.000 students), 1st for Internationalisation, 1st in Medicine, 2nd in Pharmacy, 3rd in Construction engineering-architecture, 1st for Masters in Economics, Political sciences and Communication, 2nd Best Masters in Psychology.
- **8.** It boasts a **91% employment rate within 1 year from graduation** (compared to a national average of 85%).
- **9.** It has 2 campuses (Pavia and Cremona), 25 University colleges, 37 libraries, 1,250,000 books and journals, 19 museums and collections, 4 cinemas and theatres, 30 social and cultural centres and associations, 10 schools of theatre and dance, 2 civic schools of music and arts
- **10.** Built around a student town, it allows students to mingle across different cultures, languages and engage in various extracurricular activities like theatre, sports, music etc.
