The University of Turin is one of the most ancient and prestigious Italian Universities. Hosting almost **80.000 students** (2021-2022 academic years) and with **120 buildings** in different areas in Turin and in key places in Piedmont, the University of Turin can be considered as "city-within-a-city", promoting culture and producing research, innovation, training and employment.

The University of Turin is today one of the largest Italian Universities, open to international research and training. It carries out scientific research and organizes courses in all disciplines, except for Engineering and Architecture. It is an integral part of the community, acting for reviving urban and suburban areas, promoting cultural interaction, social integration and development, encouraging dialogue and insight into current realities.

Why study at the State University of Milan?

- **1.** The University is located in Turin, administrative headquarters to Italy's fifth region, as well as Italy's first capital city from 1861 to 1865.
- 2. Like all Italian State Universities, the University of offers quality education at an extremely affordable
- 3. Over 14,900 graduates of which about 9,800 in undergraduate and 5/6-year postgraduate degree programmes over 5,100 in postgraduate degree programs. Graduate Employment Rate at 1 year after graduation stood at 64% (against the national average of 60%), Undergraduate degrees at 52% (against the national average of 45%) while the 5/6-year postgraduate degrees employment rate stood at 86% (against the national average of 78%).
- **4.** UniTo is a top European University, one of Italy's leading universities and ranks in top positions in global university rankings (THE, QS, ARWU). As leaders of the UNITA-Universitas Montium European University Alliance, UniTo has a strong engagement in research, innovation, new societal challenges and the European Green Deal.
- 5. With more than 165 programs, over 25 English-taught degrees and a wide range of joint and double degree programs, University of Turin has an extensive academic offering. Its lecturers and researchers are strongly committed to challenge-based learning. A strong visiting professors program enhances its range of courses each year.
- **6.** The University's Postgraduate and PhD programs emphasize synergies with national and international stakeholders and plenty of internship opportunities.
- 7. UniTo has about 83,000 students, 62% women, 24% from outside Piedmont Region, 7% students with foreign nationality, over 24,200 first-year students including 6% foreign students, about 1,800 students enrolled on masters of 1st and 2nd level, about 1,500 PhD students, about 1,100 disabled students and over 3,100 with specific learning disability (SLD) attesting the University all-around inclusion policy.
- **8.** UniTo has about 3,500 international students, more than 1,000 incoming and 2,000 outgoing students through the Erasmus program for study and traineeship, as well as students from all over Italy ensure a lively and exciting campus life.
- **9.** Tuition fees and life in Turin are more affordable if compared with other Italian cities. Besides, UniTo offers a wide range of student funding through scholarships and grants.
- **10.** The University is an urban campus in the heart of Turin a city with a lively cultural and youth scene which is also a most desirable and safe place to study and live.
